We were also awarded the Queen's Award for Voluntary Service in 2017 which is the equivalent of an MBE for organisations run by volunteers in the community.

A warm welcome awaits all visitors to Queen Street Stadium with the community football club ingrained in the history of non-league football.

Like most clubs at our level we have faced many ups and downs over the years but following reformation in 2007 we have not only put the club back on a steady platform financially but also re-established its reputation

in the local area as a *positive* influence for the community.

We can now look forward to building on that and, with the help of local businesses, push the club back up the non-league pyramid and increase the club profile even further.

Our club has plenty to offer our partners with exposure through our website and social media channels which spreads across the non-league scene throughout the UK with a growing following of over 3,000 just a click away including Staffordshire FA with 10,000 viewing retweeted material on their Twitter feed alone!

As well as online exposure there are around 100 matches played at *Queen Street Stadium* each

season with our first, reserve and youth team as well as links to the local college team plus additional Sunday football at our famous ground.


We also host junior cup football with *Under 13 and Under 14 Bilston Town Floodlit Cup* competitions featuring teams from all over the Midlands region.

The *Steelman's Lounge* at Queen Street is also available for hire as well as being open on matchdays in order that you quench the thirst created by cheering on your local team!

1894	The club was founded when Bilston Wanderers and Bilston Rovers amalgamated to form Bilston United FC, playing their home games at Prouds Lane playing fields, using the Spread Eagle pub as their changing rooms!
1919	The club moves to Queen Street which remains their home to this day and they kick off at their new ground with a 1-0 win over Tamworth Castle in the FA Cup.
1960	The Steelmen won the Birmingham League 'double' in 1960-61, winning both League and Cup with striker Ron McDermott scoring 78 goals that season! The early 60's saw the club enjoy one of the most successful periods in it's rich history, winning the Staffordshire Senior Cup in 1959-60, 1960-61 & 1961-62 as well as the Walsall Senior Cup in 1961-62, 1962-63 & 1963-64.
1968	Bilston reached the First Round of the FA Cup in 1968, losing 3-1 at home, to Halifax, with 4,300 packed inside Queen Street.
1973	In 1972-73 Bilston won the West Midlands League & Cup 'double', and also reached th Second Round of the FA Cup, losing 0-1 at home to Barnet in a replay.
1983	The club changed their name to Bilston Town FC and in 1985 gained promotion to the Southern League Midland Division.
2001	The Club missed out on promotion to the Conference South by a single solitary point to Tiverton Town and, following that disappointment, entered into a downward spiral of fortunes that eventualy saw them go out of business in 2005
2007	The Club reformed in 2007 and entered into the West Midlands League Division Two, playing their 'home' games at Bantock Park while Queen Street was refurbished and brought back up to standard - returning to their spiritual home in 2008.
2013	The team returned to their 'spiritual home' in 2008-09 having won promotion to Division One and in 2012-13 the club won promotion back to the Premier Division, sealing their success in front of 600 fans at Queen Street!
2014	Steelmen had a tremendous run in the FA Youth Cup with a 2nd Qualifying Round win over Hereford United on a memorable night at Queen Street although they just missed out on a 1st round match at home to Port Vale when they lost to Ellesmere Rangers in the 3rd Qualifying round.
2017	During the summer the club received the Queen's Award for Voluntary Service, the equivalent of an MBE for voluntary organisations, and are rightly proud of all those who work behind the scenes to keep the club and its community work at the forefront.
2018	The Steelmen won the Smedley Crooke Memorial Challenge Cup with a 3-2 win over Barnt Green Spartak in the final at Bewdley Town.
2022	The club appointed Mike Dunn as their new manager and he joins the club from Rushall Olympic where he managed the U21 team to cup and league success while also developing young players to transition into mens first team football.

## MATCHDAY/MATCHBALL SPONSOR


All first team home fixtures are available for sponsorship individually as is the match ball for each home game. Your brand will benefit from coverage in the build up to the game as well as on the day itself.
